Dear Villagers, Team Members, Family Members and Friends,

I am writing to inform you that testing has identified two team members having a COVID-19 positive result. At this time one team member is experiencing minor symptoms and the other team member is asymptomatic. We wish our team members well during their quarantine time and welcome them back to work soon.

On a positive note, all villagers who tested this week have come back negative. We currently have a small number of villagers on quarantine due to the positive team members. These villagers are on quarantine for 10 days.

We will continue with outbreak testing, per CMS guidelines. You will be notified if there are any new identified cases in team members or villagers.

It is important to note, that in conjunction with CMS guidelines, most visitation will still be permissible. Individuals wishing to visit are encouraged to call the established visitation hotline at 832-5977 prior to their visit to hear the latest news regarding visitation. Visitors are still screened and are asked to attest to their health prior to visiting.

We maintain that infection prevention controls, combined with proper pandemic stewardship has been instrumental in carrying us thus far. We continue to follow all guidance available to long-term care communities pertaining to pandemic response. Thank you to our team for their unrelenting attention to infection prevention and to the community for its continued support.
