Dear Villagers, Team Members, Family Members and Friends,

I am writing to inform you that testing has identified 16 new positive team members and 1 positive villager. Our villager was asymptomatic at the time of testing and was moved to our COVID area within Brewster Village for their isolation period. We wish our team members well during their isolation period and look forward to their return.

We will continue with COVID testing, per CDC guidelines. As always, we will continue to inform you of positive team members and villagers.

For the next 2 weeks the following changes have been temporarily made within Brewster Village due to the increase in positive cases at Brewster Village and within Outagamie County: 1. Our café will be closed. 2. Volunteers/Students are put on a hold. 3. Brewster Village wide activities and events are cancelled. Only household activities will be occurring. 4. All meetings not considered essential will be postponed.

At this time, we are encouraging anyone visitors who feel *any* illness or who have been exposed to COVID, to not visit at this time. This can effect quarantining requirements for our villagers and the health of our villagers and team members.
