Dear villagers, family members and friends.

This week, all Brewster Village team members were re-tested for COVID-19. I am thankful to report to you that ALL team members and villagers who were tested have received negative results. Additionally, the precautionary quarantine affecting the villagers from Heritage Square First Floor has been lifted effective today. There have been no new clusters of illness identified in anyone living in, or working at Brewster Village.

As community transmission levels continue to decrease, we will continue to ensure transparent communication with you all. However, Brewster Village will no longer be sending routine COVID-19 updates via postal mail. These updates will continue to be sent via email and posted on our website (www.brewstervillage.org). Additionally, copies will be prepared for each household, and a copy will be available among the “right to know” information in the Brewster Village Town Center. If you are currently receiving this letter via postal mail and wish to receive it via email, you may contact Brewster Village to discuss your options.

On Monday, February 28th we held a COVID-19 Moderna Booster Clinic for eligible villagers and Outagamie County employees. We had 11 County employees and 3 villagers attend this clinic. We will continue to assess and respond to the needs of a future clinic. At any point, anyone can access www.vaccines.gov to determine eligibility for COVID-19 vaccines, as well as a find a location nearby.

I also have an important update for you regarding parking for visitors at Brewster Village. Beginning Monday, March 7th and continuing for potentially several weeks, the front visitor parking lot may be partially or completely restricted as contractors and suppliers prepare for the next phase of the Roof Replacement Project (Atrium and Heritage). Visitors will need to follow the signs to the overflow parking lot during the time when parking in the front lot is impacted.
