Dear Villagers, Team Members, Family Members and Friends,

I am writing to inform you that 1 team member has tested positive for COVID-19 this week. We have received all other test results from Monday, 25th and Tuesday, 26th, which have all come back negative. We wish our team member well during their isolation period and look forward to their return. No villagers were affected by this positive result. We will continue with testing team members and villagers per CDC guidelines. As always, you will be notified if there are any new identified cases in team members or villagers.

The safety and wellbeing of our villagers is our top priority. Brewster Village is staying in close communication with local officials to ensure we are taking the appropriate steps under current circumstances. We are also following guidance from the CDC and CMS to reduce the spread and impact of COVID-19, such as:

- Screening villagers, team members and visitors for symptoms
- Testing team members and villagers for COVID-19 based on current protocols and community transmission rates
- Mandatory face masks for all team members and visitors
- Visits occurring within a villager's room or designated visitation room
- Proper hand hygiene
- Encouraging physical distancing
