Dear Villagers, Team Members, Family Members and Friends,

I am writing to inform you that 1 team member has tested positive for COVID-19 this week. We have received all other test results which are negative. We wish our team member well during their isolation period and look forward to their return. Due to the area in which this team member worked we are able to perform contact tracing testing. The first round of testing was completed on 4/5/2022. We are happy to announce that all close contacts tested negative. We will continue to test these team members next week as well. As always, you will be notified if there are any new identified cases in team members or villagers.

Our community transmission level continues to drop, however, we are still taking proper precautions to keep our villagers safe. Visitors still need to wear a form-fitted face mask when walking to/from a villager's room. Visits will continue to occur within a villager's room or designated visitation room, if needed to promote social distancing. Visits are not to take place in the café, sunrooms, living rooms, etc. Visitors are still screened and are asked to attest to their health prior to visiting.
