Dear villagers, team members, family members, and friends;

This brief letter will serve as an addition to the communication sent earlier this week on Wednesday, June 8th regarding the current COVID-19 situation at Brewster Village. In the spirit of full transparency, as well as to ensure compliance, you will continue to receive updates such as these. It is my hope that you find our updates informative and of value.

The second round of testing has identified ten additional individuals associated with Brewster Village who are positive for COVID-19. Two of the ten individuals are villagers, and are currently receiving care in the area of the building designated for this purpose. The remaining individuals are team members. Team members will be able to return to work following the CDC guidelines for healthcare workers, and villagers will be able to return to their home households based upon their symptom improvement, duration of time, and / or testing.

As I shared in my previous letter, the entirety of Symphony Place is currently in a quarantine period which is expected to last through June 15th. Again, while visitation is not restricted, visitors should consider postponing their visits until the current outbreak has subsided. Furthermore, visitors must refrain from visiting if they are COVID-19 positive or have experienced symptoms of the disease.

In addition to increased staff testing, Brewster Village will be increasing routine testing of consenting villagers, regardless of vaccination status through the duration of this outbreak.

Finally, thank you to the members of our team who are diligently working through this challenging time. You continue to be heroes in the eyes of so many.
