Dear villagers, team members, family members, and friends;

This brief update will serve as an addendum to my July 7th letter to you. As I eluded to you in that letter, COVID-19 testing took place yesterday (July 8th). Two additional team members have tested positive for COVID-19. All villager results were negative. Select affected villagers from Symphony Place and The Atrium-First Floor who were deemed to be “close contacts” will have their quarantine dates extended in accordance with CDC and CMS requirements. Visitation is open and unaffected, however visitors continue to be screened prior to entry, and are asked to postpone their visit if they are unwell.

Since positive cases continue to trickle in, we are continuing surveillance testing at a higher level than what is required. These testing efforts, in combination with additional infection control efforts are supported by the local public health department, as well as the state infection preventionist. All team members, regardless of vaccination status, will be tested again early next week. Villagers from Symphony Place will be tested again as well.

You will receive notification of any additional positive cases identified.
